

EAZA Webinars Frequently Asked Questions

The **EAZA Academy** puts on a **webinar series**, below are FAQ related to the webinar series.

1 How long is the presentation?

The webinars are an hour long with 45 minutes for the presentation and 15 minutes for participant questions.

2 What platform are the webinars held?

The webinars are held on Zoom, registration is required but it's free to attend.

3 Does the webinar have to be on a specific topic or theme?

The webinar topic is chosen by the presenter and doesn't have to be a specific theme. As long as the content relates to zoos and aquariums, you are welcome to propose it.

4 Does the webinar have to follow specific guidelines?

Yes, the webinar must be applicable to the EAZA audience and focused on how the information can be practically used to support zoos and aquariums. The content must also follow the topic and brief description agreed with the EAZA Academy.

5 Does the webinar have to be in English?

Yes, English is the official language of EAZA. Presenting in English allows us to support members from many different regions. If English is not your first language and you are considering presenting, please know that we would be very happy to have you and can provide support with the English in your presentation upon request.

6 When do the webinars occur?

Typically, on Wednesday's at 13:00CET, if you are presenting in a different time-zone we're happy to work with you to adjust the timing where possible.

7 Do I need to do my presentation live?

No, you may also choose to submit a pre-recorded version of your presentation and provide your email address so participants can contact you with individual questions.

8 How do I share my interest in doing a webinar?

9 Say I want to do a webinar, what kind of information do you need?

Once an available date has been agreed upon, we will need the following:

1. Final presentation title
2. Your name and institution/Committee/TAG affiliation, as you would like it to appear in promotional materials
3. A brief description of the topic (100–150 words), including the intended target audience
4. A photo of you
5. A short biography (approximately 100 words)
